

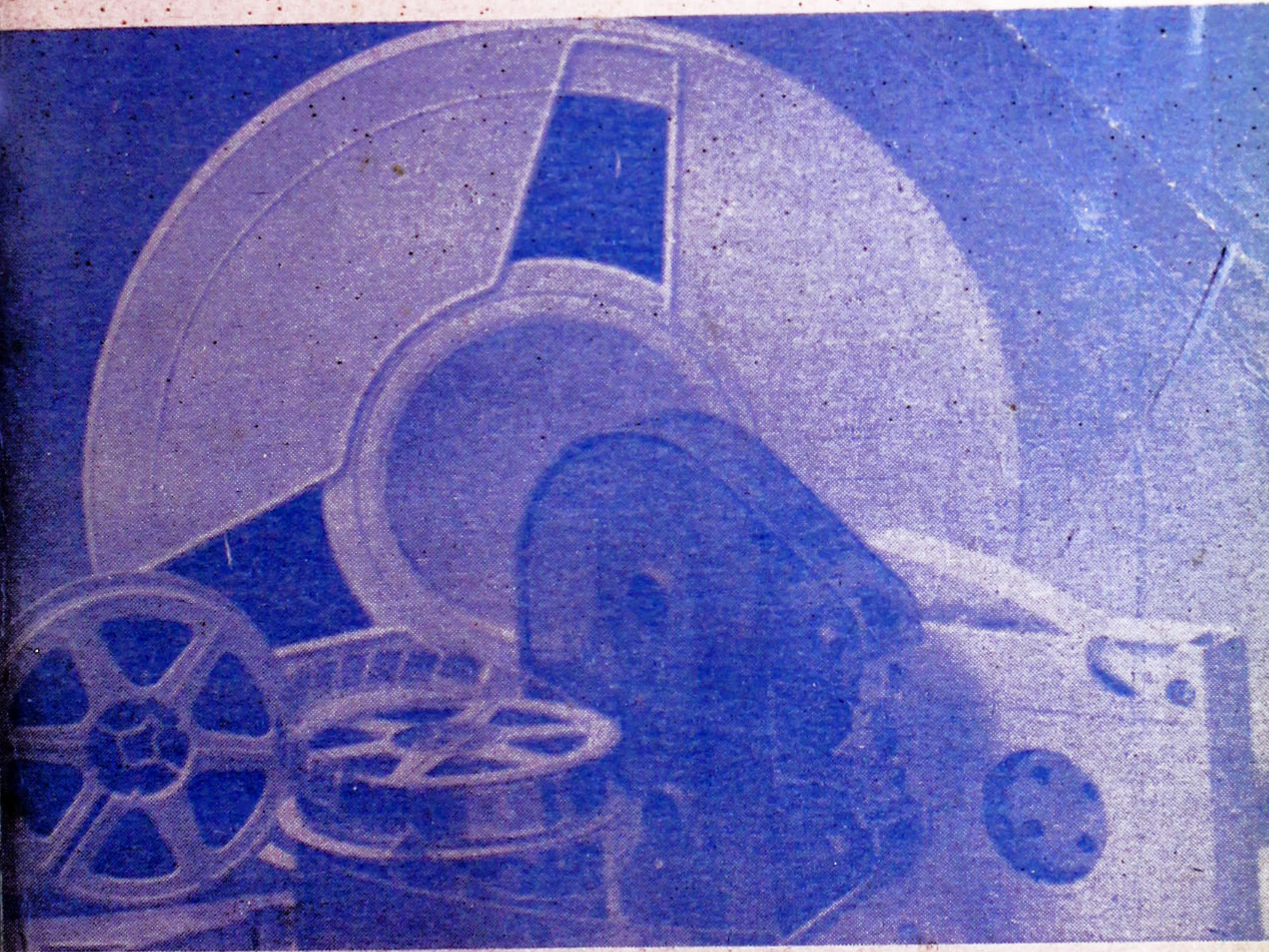

INTRODUCTION

This is the first effort towards Indexing and cataloguing source materials available on microfilms in the National Archives of Pakistan. The idea of co-ordinating the microfilming work and the formation of a Microfilming Committee demand that efforts should be made to establish closer cooperation amongst **organizations engaged in collecting and preserving source materials on microfilms.** This can be achieved partly by publishing Indices and catalogues of **such materials.** This volume is therefore, a step in this direction.

The first volume has therefore been divided into two parts *i.e.* Part-I and Part-II. **The Part-I is an Index of microfilms of important source materials.** However, this portion of the first volume is more important in my opinion particularly now when we are celebrating the Birth Centenary of Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah. It contains useful information about source materials relevant for study and research on Mohammad Ali Jinnah and Muslim League available on microfilms at Islamabad in the National Archives of Pakistan in addition to original collection of Quaid-e-Azam papers.

The collections treated in Part-I are (1) Quaid-e-Azam Papers (2) Muslim League Records (3) Syed Shamsul Hassan's Collection (4) Newspapers *i.e.* The Civil and Military Gazette, The Pioneer. The Mofusilite and The Indian Public opinion.

I. QUAID-E-AZAM PAPERS

The collection of Quaid-e-Azam Papers in Islamabad consists of more than one lac pages. In addition, the collection contains a number of pamphlets, brochures, booklets relating to the struggle of Muslims in combined India. The collection of Quaid-e-Azam Papers has been microfilmed (excluding the printed material). These microfilms are available to research scholars for consultation. There are 67 microfilm rolls of 100 ft. each. It may also be pointed out that this collection has also been accessioned and is being supplemented by the Descriptive Catalogue. The Accessions List was published in 5 parts and Descriptive Catalogue in four parts. Since the original collection has already been provided with sufficient finding aids as such it has not been included in this work.

II. THE ALL INDIA MUSLIM LEAGUE RECORDS

The microfilms of these valuable records were prepared by this Department with a view to provide maximum amount of facility to the research scholars working on Quaid-e-Azam Papers. Originally, these papers were at Delhi and soon after the Partition, were brought to Pakistan. The records remained sealed from 1958 to 1966. These old records of the All-India Muslim League were shifted to Karachi University for restoration and preservation in October, 1966. Most

of the papers have since been repaired and restored and form a valuable record of the Freedom Movement Archives, Karachi University. As soon the permanent building of the National Archives of Pakistan is complete at Islamabad, all these papers will be transferred to its permanent abode. The period covered by these papers is from 1900 to 1948. So far we have microfilmed 292 volumes of this important collection. Some of the important titles are :—

- (1) Early efforts towards Political re-organization (1900—1940).
- (2) Morely-Minto Reforms (1908).
- (3) Bengal Provincial Muslim League (1908—1945).
- (4) All India Muslim League and the Muslim World.
- (5) Council Meetings of the All India Muslim League.
- (6) Constitutional Development of the All India Muslim League.
- (7) Hindu-Muslim Unity (Communal Affairs).
- (8) Annual Sessions of the All India Muslim League.

III. SYED SHAMSUL HASSAN'S COLLECTION

These papers, although a part of the All-India Muslim League Records form a separate archival group. This collection comprising of thirty-three volumes (5,722 pages) was handed over by Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah to Syed Shamsul Hassan, Secretary of the All India Muslim League. The Department was able to microfilm these papers with the cooperation of Mr. Shamsul Hassan's son Mr. Wajid. This collection on microfilms has been placed along with Jinnah papers for the convenience of scholars.

Some of the important titles found in these papers which may be of some interest to the research scholars, are :—

- (1) General Correspondence of Personalities and Organizations.
- (2) Correspondence of Non-Muslim Personalities like, C. Rajagopalacharia, K. N. Cripps, etc.
- (3) Hyderabad (Deccan) Correspondence with The Nizam, Bahadur Yar Jang, Mir Laiq Ali, Dr. S. A. Latif, etc.
- (4) Punjab ; Nawab of Mamdot, Mian Mumtaz Daultana, Mian Bashir Ahmad, Sardar Shaukat Hyat Khan, etc.
- (5) Bengal : Correspondence with Khawaja Nazimuddin, H. S. Suhrawardy, Ahmad Ispahani, etc.
- (6) Students : All India Muslim League Federation.

IV. NEWSPAPERS i.e. THE CIVIL AND MILITARY GAZETTE, THE PIONEER ETC.

This group consists mainly of two leading English newspapers i.e. The Civil and Military Gazette and The Pioneer. The Civil and Military Gazette, a daily published from Lahore (for sometimes published from Simla, also as a weekly), was one of the leading English newspapers. It is a good contemporary source material on the political situation etc. of this area. The period covered by this paper is from 1873 to 1963. The dak-issues of this newspaper (1932 –1963) have also been microfilmed. Three hundred and seventy-five rolls of hundred feet each of microfilms cover this valuable record and is available to research scholars for consultation.

The "Pioneer" was also an English daily and was published from Allahabad. The period covered by it is from 1895 to 1933. One hundred and twenty-seven rolls of microfilm of hundred feet each have been used to microfilm this collection. In addition we have twelve rolls of microfilms of "The Mofussilite" covering period from 1848—1873. Further we have twenty-four rolls covering "The Indian Public Opinion" from 1866—1876.

The microfilming project of these newspapers was possible only with the co-operation of Mr. Nasir Ahmad Sheikh, Managing Director, Colony Textile Mills Ltd. we are grateful to him for this cooperation. This will be of great value to historians and research scholars. He has also agreed to donate the originals of these papers to the National Archives of Pakistan.

The source materials included in Part-II was microfilmed by the National Archives though the original is not in its possession. This material has, therefore, been collected from various sources such as National Library, National Museum, State Bank Library, Khairpur Library and from individuals possessing valuable collections of source material. This part enlists 440 entries which have been classified into various broad subject heads. History taken as a major subject has been sub-divided into the following :—

- (1) History of Arabs.
- (2) History of Persia.
- (3) History of Afghanistan.
- (4) History of Pakistan ;
- (5) History of India :
 - (i) Early period.
 - (ii) Mughal period.
 - (iii) British period.
 - (iv) General.
 - (v) Geography.
 - (vi) Biography.

The history of the All India Muslim League can be seen under the subject head "All India Muslim League". Muslim League entries have been arranged into the following groups :—

- (1) Constitution and Rules.
- (2) Resolutions.
- (3) Proceedings.
- (4) Presidential Addresses.
- (5) Reports.
- (6) General.

The other important subjects dealt with are Archives and Library, Religion, Public Administration, Social welfare, Fine Arts, Language and Literature.

The entries are author-entries. The works whose author could not traced, have been entered with their titles. Similarly where the publisher of the work could not be traced, the name of the printer has been given. The microfilm roll number appears at the end of each entry on the right hand corner. The numbers in parenthesis indicate the strip numbers (Roman figures) or the page numbers (Arabic figures).

The research scholars may find confusion with regard to the spellings of some of the names of places|persons appearing in the title. This is so because we have tried to reproduce the originals. The unnecessary parts of a title have been deleted.

Each entry provides the following information with regard to a work, (1) Auditor|Compiler (2) Title of the work (3) Place of publication (4) Publisher|Printers (5) Year of Publication (6) Number of pages (7) Language and (8) Roll number.

We have not indicated the source from where we obtained the originals for microfilming. However, we will provide information in this regard on individual enquiries from scholars interested in knowing the location of the originals.

A number of abbreviations have been used in this work, which have been explained in Appendix "A". For Part-II two indices *i.e.* a title index and an author index, have also been added at the end as Appendices B & C respectively. I am grateful to Mr. Masood Ahmad Khan, Assistant Director and Mr. Ashraf Ali, Deputy Director who have worked hard in the compilation of this work.
