PRAYER (DU'A)

The word DU'A is generally used for supplication and distinguished from SALAT (the liturgical form of prayer.)

- 2. But since DU'A is the essence of Faith in Allah, it is also known as prayer.
- 3. For example, Surah 14-40.

"O my Lord! Make me and my posterity to be constant in prayer (SALAH).

O our Lord! And accept my supplication (DU'A)"

- 4. Supplication formally and literally, means a humble appeal, petition or prayer beseeching mercy, favour, help or anything.
- 5. Allah is Glorified. He Alone is The Ever All- Creator, Sustainer, Cherisher, Owner of limit-less Bounties, Bestower, Gracious, Generous, Protector, Oft-Forgiving, Merciful and Beneficent. To supplicate earnestly before Him is a way to acknowledge our bondage to the Creator and surrender our selves in reverence as a manifestation of our Faith and Trust n His Ever All-Powerful, Ever All-Merciful and Ever All-Beneficent Essence and Attributes.
 - In Surah Momin (40), verse 60, Allah has decreed:

"Pray unto Me and I will answer your prayers. Verily, those who are too arrogant to call Me will find themselves in Hell, disgraced and humiliated".

7. In Surah Baqarah(2), verse 186, Allah says:

"When My slaves ask (You,O Prophet!) about Me (tell them that) I am indeed close to them. I answer the prayers of every supplicant when he calls on Me. So let them obey Me and believe in Me. So that they may be rightly led".

- 8. The Holy Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.) said that the one in whom a desire to pray is kindled, is going to receive the benefits and blessings for his supplication.
- 9. The Holy Prophet (S.A.W.) further said that nothing can alter the destiny except the prayer made in earnest.
- 10. Prayer is a psychological, spiritual and true source of support and benefit in all afflictions, adversities and misfortunes.
- 11. Whoever wishes fulfillment of his prayers he must have fear of Allah, firm Faith and Trust in All His Essence and Attributes, and piety and perseverance in righteous conduct.

- 12. It is essential to keep unshakeable faith in the Mercy of Allah with patience and subjection to His Will as manifest in His Dictates and Decrees, and design of things and events. If one doesn't feel the immediate response of the prayer, it may be due to:
 - i) lack of such an understanding or spiritual feeling,

or

ii) the things might have been arranged in a better way and without ill effects which would have otherwise entailed,

or

iii) the arrangement within a certain frame of time and place,

or

- iv) its not being fair and just or beneficial.
- 13. A prayer with just objective and in right earnest does not go waste.
- 14. Therefore, one should not pray in haste and with impatience.
- 15. A prayer has several visible and spiritual aspects of Beneficence of Allah, The Ever All-Compassionate, The Ever All-Merciful.
- 16. We have imperfect and limited vision. We don't understand the subtleties of design and appropriate timings when

we need a particular thing. One receives the benefit of Prayer in one or the other or even better form provided one does not lose heart or hope or seek refuge with powerless creatures or things.

- 17. Oneness of the worship of Allah strictly and minutely prohibits all forms of praying, invoking, beseeching, putting trust in and dependence on anyone or anything except the One, the Only, the Alone Allah The Ever All-Powerful.
- 18. Believing or ascribing that the source of power, favour, fear etc, can come from anyone beside Allah is included in SHIRK (Polytheism).
- 19. May Allah bless us with His Beneficence and Mercies, without stint, for submission, obedience, patience and trust in Him (Ameen).
